Questions to ask your surgeon

If you have just received a diagnosis of breast cancer and surgery is recommended, here are some questions to ask that may help with your decision making.

- What is the best surgery for me?
- What are the risks and potential complications?
 How do these compare with the benefits?
- Can I choose between having the lump removed and a mastectomy?
- How will my breast look after surgery?
- Is reconstruction an option for me?
- If I have a mastectomy, how likely is it that I'll need radiotherapy?
- Is chemotherapy before surgery an option for me?
- How long will I be in hospital?
- How much time should I allow for recovery at home?
- When will my first follow-up appointment be?
- What should I expect after surgery? Pain, swelling, numbness?
- Will I need any further treatment after surgery?
- When can I go back to work and resume normal activities?
- What is my risk of lymphoedema?
- What activities should I not do while I am recovering at home?
